<u>Rules:</u> The current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the prescriptions of RYA, the SCIRA Rules of Conduct for Conducting National Championships, the Deed of Gift and the Sailing Instructions shall be in effect.

In case of conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the sailing instructions shall prevail.

<u>Advertising</u>: This regatta is classified as Category C in accordance with the RRS and SCIRA Advertising Prescription.

<u>Entry and Eligibility</u>: This regatta is open to SCIRA registered boats, <u>helm and crew</u> in good standing for 2007 and subject to any Deed of Gift trophy restrictions.

Measurement:

(1) All boats shall provide a valid measurement certificate and are subject to measurement at any time at the discretion of the class or the race committee.

(2) All boats are required to have a current Class decal properly displayed

Sailing Instructions: The regatta Sailing Instructions will be available at registration

<u>Courses</u>: The courses to be sailed are the Class approved courses for National Championships as published in the current SCIRA Official Handbook.

"Black Flag": The Race Officer will have the option to use Rule 30.3 in this regatta.

<u>Scoring</u>: The SCIRA Low Point scoring system will be used. If 4 or more race are sailed one result will be discarded. 3 races sailed will constitute a championship.

Medway Cup:	Skipper of the second boat overall
King George SC Trophy:	Crew of the second boat overall
John Broughton Masters Trophy:	Highest placed skipper over the age of 45
