







The "Sports Nautiques de l'Eau d'Heure (ASBL)" club & The Belgian and French Snipe Class Associations invite you for the Third round of the 10th Yves LE BOUR Trophy 29-30th September 2007

NOTICE OF RACE

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority Sports Nautiques de l'Eau d'Heure club (S.N.E.H.) in cooperation with the Belgian and French Snipe Class Associations (ABS & AFS) and under patronages of the Belgian French Federation of Yachting (F.F.Y.B.) and the Royal Belgian Federation of Yachting (F.R.B.Y.).

1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008*. (RRS)

- 1.2. The prescriptions of the Belgian authority will be apply.
- 1.3. The rules for the navigation on the Plate Taille lake will be apply.

1.4. Appendix P will be apply as changed by:

(a) Rule P2.3 will not apply and rule P2.2 is changed so that it will apply to any protest after the first one.

1.5. Snipe class rules will apply and regulations of the "Yves LE BOUR Trophy".

1.6. The sailing instructions (SI) may change the Racing Rules, the Class Rules and the rules of these NOR.

If there is conflict between languages the French text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category C according to RRS 79 and Advertising Code – Regulation 20 and special restriction:

BELGIUM (LAW of 10/12/1997): Advertising for tobacco products is prohibited

Boat may be required to display advertising of the event sponsor on each side on the forward 25% of the hull.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the Snipe class.

Each competitor shall be full member of their class association and holder of a valid sailing license as required by its federation.

4. FEES

4.1. Required fees are as follows:

Boat entry fee: **EUR 25.** Payment in cash (Euro) during enrolment at the registration desk.

5. SCHEDULE

Registration:

Saturday, 29th September from 1000 to 1200

Racing is scheduled as follows:

The number of races scheduled is six (6).

The scheduled times for the races are:

- On Saturday, 29th September 2007
 - First start signal at 1300.
 - o Limit time for the last start 1800
- On Sunday, 30th September 2007
 - o First start signal at 1000.
 - o Limit time for the last start 1530

Social events:

- Saturday, 29th September 2007 at about 2000, Sailors banquet (not mandatory, reserved during registration)
- Sunday, 30th September 2007 at about 1700 price giving.

6. EQUIPMENT AND MEASUREMENTS CHEKS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement or rating certificate.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 1000 on Saturday, 29th September 2007 at the regatta office.

8. LOCATION

The regatta will be held at lake of the Plate Taille in Belgium, simultaneously with a Cadets Regatta (separated notice).

Attachment shows the location of the Plate Taille lake.

9. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as follows:

Trapezoid Courses. (See RRS Appendix L Addendum A)

10.PENALTY SYSTEM

As RRS.

11.SCORING

- 11.1. Ranking according to the regulations of the "Yves LE BOUR Trophy" for the trophy.
- 11.2. The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply
- 11.3. Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.4.

- 11.4.(a). When fewer then four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.4.(b). When four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall

- Ask authorization to go afloat by filling in a request form.
- Must help to rescue on demand of the race committee.
- Be marked with national flag.

13. BERTHING

Boats and trailers shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park.

14. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except:

- with and according to the terms of prior permission of the race committee.
- after the last race of the day.

15. RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

16. PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

- The first of the Third round of the 10th Yves LE BOUR Trophy.
- The 10th Challenge will be awarded to the first of all results that constitute the Yves LE BOUR Trophy for the year 2007.
- One prize by boat.

17. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of EUR 500 000,00 per event or the equivalent.
