Royal Danish Yacht Club in conjunction with Espergærde Yacht Club and
the Snipe Class International Racing Association (SCIRA).

1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by:

- 1.1 The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. (RRS)
- 1.2 The SCIRA Rules of Conduct for Conducting National and International Championship Regattas
- 1.3 The Deed of Gift.
- 1.4 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.5 The decision of the jury will be final in accordance with RRS 70.5.
- 1.6 RRS Appendix P will apply.
- 1.7 RRS 35 will be changed to provide that boats not finishing within 30 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored "Did Not Finish" without a hearing.
- 1.8 RRS 62.2 and 66 will be changed to shorten the time for requesting redress and the requesting that a hearing be re-opened on the last day of racing.
- 1.9 RRS 30.3 will not be used.
- 1.10 RRS 32 and 33 will be changed to limit course changes
- 1.11 RRS 60.1(a) will be changed to restrict protest from boats for specific items on the NoR and SI.
- 1.12 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING:

- 2.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 and SCIRA rules
- 2.2 Boats may be requested to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY:

- 3.1 This regatta is open to SCIRA registered boats and Class Member skippers and crews who are in good standing with their fleet, country, ISAF and SCIRA and sailing a Snipe registered to SCIRA for the current year.
- 3.2 In case of chartered or loaned boat, the skipper may use the sail number of his/her own boat and both boats shall be registered to SCIRA for the current year.

- 3.3 All skippers must be citizens, or bonafide residents for at least one year, of the country they represent and each must present credentials signed by the National Secretary attesting that he/she is the entrant.
- 3.4 No skipper or crew shall be eligible to enter any Class championship race unless:
- they possess and present a current Class Membership Card, or
 - SCIRA-issued equivalent, or
 - shows as current member in the SCIRA Official Online Database.
- 3.5 Competitors shall establish with SCIRA their entry approval through their own National Secretary.
- 3.6 Bow numbers are assigned at registration and it shall be each competitor's sole responsibility to properly affix them in conformance with the instructions and to properly maintain them.

4. FEES:

- 4.1 The entry fee is 350 EUR to be paid before July 15th 2011.
The entry fee includes admission to social events for the competitors.

5. SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration:

August 5th - 13th 2011. Regatta Office opening hours 08:00-18:00
All competitors must register no later than the close of measurement 18:00 August 9th.

5.2 Measurement:

August 5th - 9th 2011. Measurement opening hours 08:00-18:00
All competitors must complete measurement no later than one hour before first warning signal in first race.

5.3 Schedule of Races:

August 9th 2011, Tune up race (13:55 warning signal)
August 10th 2011 Three races scheduled (10:55 warning signal 1. race)
August 11th 2011 Three races scheduled (10:55 warning signal 1. race)
August 12th 2011 Three races scheduled (10:55 warning signal 1. race)
August 13th 2011 Two races scheduled (10:55 warning signal 1. race)

Three races are required for the Championship. Eleven races are scheduled.
Starting procedure for a subsequent race is scheduled to take place as soon as possible after the previous race has been completed.

5.4 Social

August 9th 2011 Opening ceremony at 18:00 hours
August 13th 2011 Regatta dinner and prize giving ceremony

6. MEASUREMENT:

- 6.1 Measurement will take place in the location of Royal Danish Yacht Club, Rungsted Harbor
- 6.2 All boats shall produce a valid measurement certificate and are subject to measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the Class or Race Committee.
- 6.3 All boats are required to have a current Class decal properly displayed.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The Sailing Instructions will be available two weeks before the start of the regatta on <http://snipeworlds.kdy.dk/>

8. VENUE.

Races will be sailed in Øresund east of Rungsted Havn, Danish Chart No. 131.

9. COURSES:

The courses to be sailed are the Class approved courses for international regattas as published in the current SCIRA Official Rulebook and SCIRA web site.

10. SCORING:

The low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply, modified according to SCIRA Deed of Gift.

11. SUPPORT BOATS:

Support boats shall register, within the limits specified in 5.1 above, to the Organizing Committee that will assign an identification to be shown visible on the boat throughout the event.

12. INSURANCE:

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of EUR 670.000,- per event for personal damage and EUR 270.000,- per event for material damage or equivalent.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION:

13.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats.

13.2 This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15 PRIZES:

Prizes will be given as follows:

Commodore Hub E. Isaacks Trophy will be awarded to the overall winning team.

There will be honorable prizes for every fifth boats registered. (Max. 10 prizes).
